Gympie, has an important and colourful history, such as being known as the "Town that saved Queensland from Bankruptcy".

Everybody is invited to visit our Museum where you can find out just how Gympie saved Queensland and much more of its past and present.

The Museum houses a vast collection of documentation, artefacts and photographs from the discovery of gold in 1867 by James Nash to the current operations of the Gympie Eldorado Goldmine which is the 8th greatest gold producing mine in Australia today.

The Museum site comprises over 5 hectares containing over 30 display areas in and around 15 major buildings with entry through a café and souvenir shop.



We not only encourage Families to visit, but we are also open to Group Tours, School Groups, Guides and there are Concessions for Students, Pensioners, Special Rates for Families.

Inspect the still-operating 110-year-old steam winding engine (see above), used to lower and raise miners and ore carts into the mines, and the original home of Gympie's famous Prime Minister, Andrew Nash, Australia's second Labor prime Minister (1908-1915).

Our Museum Markets run every 1st, 3rd and 5th Sunday of the month without fail - even over Christmas and New Year. These are a major source of income for the museum, which is fully funded by volunteers work, the Cafe, entry fees and the markets. Market Dates: Nov. 16, 30, Dec. 7 and 21
