The Allan Cunningham Motel is a proud member of the Paragon Motel Chain.

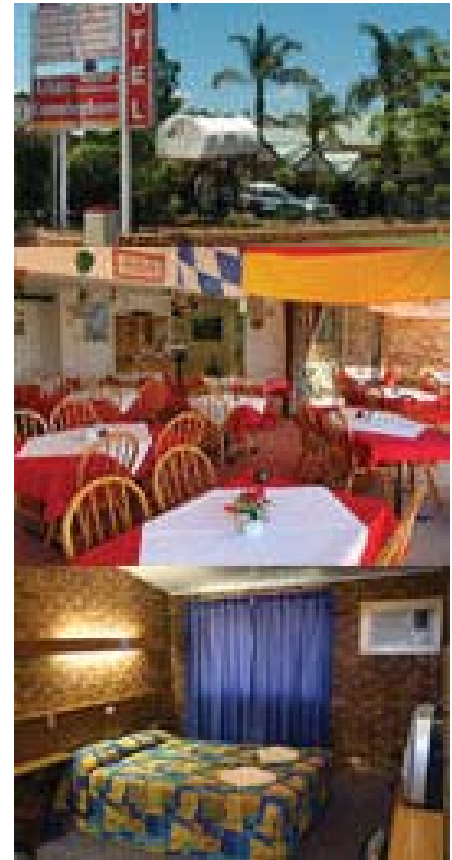

Other features include; saltwater swimming pool, Austar Pay TV, Guest Laundry, off-street or under cover parking depending on the room.

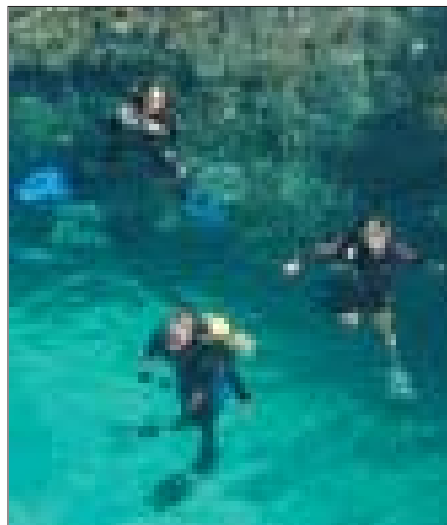


# Cape Tribulation Camping Ground
